There is no limit to the number of abstracts you may submit, however a single author may abstracts (see "Presenting Author" section below). There is no fee for submission.

Abstract Specifications

- 1. Maximum number of authors: 10 (including the lead author)
- 2. Word limit: 250 words for entire abstract, <u>not</u> including the title, author string, or table/figure.
- 3. Structure: Introduction, Methods, Results, and Conclusions
- 4. Table or figure criteria:
 - One table <u>or</u> figure per abstract
 - No identifying information for authors or institutions
 - Tables must not contain more than five columns or ten rows
